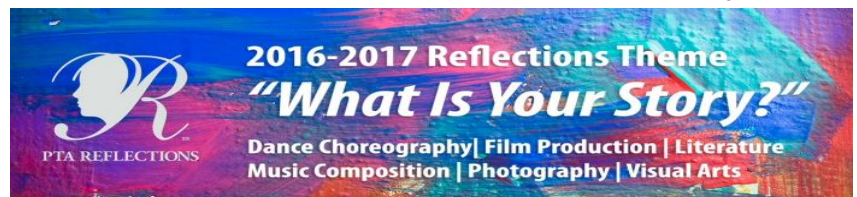
Greetings Parents, Teachers and Students!
